As a Practitioner of the Ceremonial Arts I agree to . . .

1. Maintain the highest standards of professional and ethical conduct in my practice as a Ceremonial Guide.
2. Show respect and dignity to all clients.
3. Keep it positive and respectfully talk about other practitioners and healing modalities.
4. Be responsible for the energy I bring to all areas of my life including my client work.
5. Maintain client confidentiality.
6. Accurately represent my experience, skills, and abilities.
7. Only utilize healing techniques and modalities that I have received proper training and/or certification to perform.
8. Bring deep honor and reverence to my clients and their unique journey by empowering them to be both an active participant and also responsible for their healing journey.
9. Bring full presence and reverence to my sacred work, honoring all of life.
10. Abstain from the use of drugs or alcohol during all professional activities.
11. Decline offering medical diagnosis, interfering with medical treatment, or suggesting changes in medical treatment including medications.
12. Continue to develop my skills as a practitioner through personal development and healing.
13. Expand my practice and professional knowledge through continuing education, practice, and other professional trainings.
14. Learn and uphold the most current local, state, and federal laws specific to my areas of practice.
